SUBJECT: TR-7 TOWING

MODEL: Triumph TR-7

In the event an owner intends to trail tow a TR-7 equipped with a five speed transmission or an automatic transmission, special precautions must be taken to avoid transmission damage.

Five Speed - Vehicles being towed over 25 miles must have the driveshaft removed to avoid gear damage since the engine driven transmission oil pump is inoperative in tow.

Automatic - Vehicles equipped with automatic transmission may be safely towed for 30 miles at speeds not to exceed 50 mph by adding 1-1/2 pints of automatic transmission fluid* to the transmission. For long distance towing the driveshaft must be removed to avoid transmission damage.

*Remember to drain excess fluid before normal operation.
